1.- Types and uses

The service uses its own and Third-Party cookies to provide assistance, improve navigation and obtain statistics on the use of the web page.

2.- What is a cookie and what is it used for?

A cookie is a text file which is sent to the web navigator of your computer, mobile phone or tablet and serves to store and recuperate information on the navigation carried out.

For example, to remember your user name and password or the preferences of your profile.

3.- What types of cookies are there?

There are, according to who manages them:

- Own cookies; these are sent to your navigator from our team or web domain.
- Third-Party cookies; these are sent to your navigator from a team or web domain that is not managed by us directly, like Google for example.

Depending on the time that they remain active, there are:

- Sessional cookies; these will stay in the cookie archives of your navigator until you abandon the web page, so that none remain on your device.

- Persistent cookies; these will remain on our device and our web registers them every time that you make a new visit. These cookies stop working after a certain date.

Finally, and according to the purpose required, we have:

- Technical Cookies; these improve navigation and the good functioning of the web.
- Personalization cookies; these permit the access to a service with pre-defined characteristics, according to a particular set of criteria.
- Analysis cookies: these permit the measure and statistical analysis of the use of the service.
